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Section 1 – Notice Inviting Tender (NIT)

Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar invites sealed competitive bids under a **Two-Bid System (Technical Bid and Financial Bid)** from eligible and resourceful suppliers for the supply, transportation and delivery of saplings & ornamental plants as detailed in this document.

Section 2 – Important Dates (Critical Date Sheet)

Note: In case any date specified above happens to be a declared holiday, the next working day shall be deemed to be the relevant date, with timings remaining unchanged.

Section 3 – Instructions to Bidders (ITB)

3.1 General

- Each bidder shall submit both technical bid & Financial bid.
- Bids must be submitted either by Speed Post / Registered Post or delivered and deposited in the designated Tender Box at the office of RPRC on or before the stipulated date and time specified in the Notice Inviting Tender (NIT). Bids must be enclosed in sealed covers, duly superscribed with the tender reference number, name of work, and due date, and addressed to the designated tender-receiving authority.
- The bidder shall be solely responsible for ensuring that the bid reaches the prescribed destination within the stipulated date and time. RPRC shall not be responsible for any postal, or transit delays, loss, or mis-delivery, irrespective of the date of posting. Tenders received after the prescribed deadline, for any reason whatsoever, shall be treated as late tenders and summarily rejected without any further reference to the bidder.
- Bids submitted by any mode other than those prescribed above shall not be accepted.

3.2 Cost of Bidding

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid. RPRC shall in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

3.3 Amendment of Tender Document

At any time prior to the last date for submission of bids, RPRC may, for any reason, whether on its own initiative or in response to a clarification sought by a bidder, modify the tender document by issuing a corrigendum on the portal. To give bidders reasonable time to take the amendment into account, RPRC may, at its discretion, extend the last date for submission of bids.

3.4 Language and Currency

The bid and all related correspondence shall be in English or Odia. All rates and amounts shall be quoted in Indian Rupees (₹) only.

3.5 Period of Validity of Bids

Bids shall remain valid for a period of 120 (one hundred twenty) days from the last date of submission of bids. A bid valid for an Opener period shall be rejected as non-responsive. In exceptional circumstances, RPRC may request bidders to extend the validity period; such request and the responses shall be in writing, and a bidder may refuse the request without forfeiture of EMD.

3.6 Right to Accept / Reject

RPRC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, in whole or in part, and to annul the bidding process at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) and without any obligation to assign reasons therefor.

Section 4 – Eligibility Criteria

Only those bidders meeting the following minimum, essential eligibility conditions shall be considered for technical evaluation.

Sl.	Criterion	Requirement
a	Legal Status / Constitution	The bidder shall be a nursery, horticulture firm, proprietorship, partnership firm, company, registered Self-Help Group (SHG), Farmer Producer Organization (FPO), cooperative society, or Micro/Small/Medium Enterprise (MSME) engaged in the business of growing/supplying plants and saplings for 3 years on 30.06.2026. Self-attested copy of registration / constitution document to be furnished.
b	Experience	The bidder should have minimum 3Years experience of supply of plants/saplings/ornamental or flowering plants to any Government / Semi-Government / PSU / Local Authority during the last three financial years. One satisfactory supply/work order or completion certificate to be furnished issued by Government Department/ PSU/ Government Agency should be submitted with the Technical Bid.
c	PAN	The bidder shall hold a valid Permanent Account Number (PAN). Self-attested copy to be furnished.
d	GST Registration	The bidder shall hold a valid GST Registration. Self-attested copy to be furnished.
e	Annual Turnover	The firm should have minimum 1:00 Crore turnover for minimum three financial years out of last five Year (Supported with relevant Document)
f	EMD	The bidder shall furnish EMD as per Section 4.1 / Clause below, or a valid exemption document where exemption is claimed.
g	Non-Blacklisting	The bidder shall not be blacklisted / debarred by any Government Department, PSU or Government agency in India as on the date of bid submission. A self-declaration in the prescribed format (Annexure I) to be furnished.

4.1 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- EMD of ₹ 44,000/- (Rupees Forty four Thousand only), shall be furnished (/ portal payment gateway) or by Demand Draft / Banker' Cheque or by NEFT / RTGS in favour of Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre at Bhubaneswar,
- EXEMPTION: Bidders registered as Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) with valid Udyam Registration are exempt from payment of EMD on submission of a self-attested copy of the relevant registration/exemption certificate, in line with the Public Procurement Policy for MSEs and the MSME/Startup policy of the Government of Odisha, as amended.
- The Earnest Money Deposit of the unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded without interest within 30 (thirty) days from the date of award of contract.
- In the case of the successful bidder, the Earnest Money Deposit may, on written request of the successful bidder and subject to approval of RPRC, be adjusted against the required Performance Security to the extent of the EMD amount available with RPRC. If the prescribed Performance Security exceeds the EMD amount, the successful bidder shall deposit the balance amount within the time stipulated in the Letter of Award.
- EMD shall be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or modifies its bid during the validity period, or if the successful bidder fails to furnish the Security Deposit or to execute the agreement within the stipulated time.

Section 5 – Scope of Work / Supply

The scope of supply comprises supply, transportation and delivery of healthy, disease-free, well-rooted plants of the categories and indicative quantities specified in the Technical Bid (Section 19), at the designated site(s), together with all incidental services. The broad scope includes:

- Supply of saplings suitable for roadside, campus and boundary plantation.
- Supply of ornamental plants (foliage and flowering shrubs, hedge plants, palms, etc.) for landscaping and beautification.
- Supply of indigenous / native species suitable for the agro-climatic conditions of Odisha, and such other plants as may be required and ordered within the scope of the rate contract / supply order.
- Loading, transportation, unloading and delivery of all plants at the designated site(s) at the bidder's cost and risk.
- Replacement, free of cost, of any plant found damaged, diseased, wilted, broken or dead at the time of delivery / inspection (see Section 11).
- Supply of plants in appropriate containers/poly-bags/earthen balls with adequate ball of earth, as per the technical specifications.

Quantity variation: The quantities indicated are estimates. RPRC reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity of any item, or to delete any item, by up to $\pm 25\%$ at the same accepted unit rates, depending on actual requirement and availability of funds, without any change in the terms and conditions.

Section 6 – Technical Specifications of Plants

6.1 General Quality Standards

- All plants/saplings shall be healthy, vigorous, well-established, true to species/variety, and free from pests, diseases, deficiencies and physical damage.
- Saplings shall be supplied in poly-bags / containers of appropriate size with adequate, intact ball of earth; root systems shall be well-developed and not pot-bound or deformed.
- Saplings/ Ornamental Plants shall generally as specified item-wise with a straight, healthy stem, unless otherwise specified.
- Ornamental and hedge plants shall be bushy, well-branched and of the height/spread specified item-wise.
- Plants shall be acclimatized (hardened) and fit for immediate transplantation at the delivery site.
- Each lot/species shall, where required, be accompanied by a label indicating the botanical/common name and variety.

6.2 Indicative Species / Categories

The indicative list represents the species commonly required. Final species and quantities shall be as per the Technical Bid (Section 19) and the Supply Order. Equivalent native substitutes may be permitted with prior written approval.

Section 7 – Bid Submission Procedure (Two-Bid System)

Bids shall be submitted in **two parts** — Part-I: Technical Bid and Part-II: Financial Bid. The Financial Bid shall not contain any condition; conditional Financial Bids are liable to rejection.

7.1 Part-I: Technical Bid (Cover-1)

- Copy of registration / constitution document (nursery / firm / company / SHG / FPO / cooperative / Udyam).
- Self-attested copy of PAN.
- Self-attested copy of GST Registration Certificate, or self-declaration of non-liability to register (Section 13).
- Proof of experience – copy of one supply/work order or completion/satisfactory performance certificate (or self-declaration of capability for newly formed SHGs/FPOs).
- Proof of EMD payment, or valid EMD exemption document (Udyam/MSE/SHG/FPO).
- Duly filled and signed Bid Form (Section 18).
- Declaration of non-blacklisting and Integrity Pact / Anti-Corruption declaration (Annexures).
- Unpriced copy of the Financial Bid (Bill of Quantities) indicating 'Quoted' against each item, **WITHOUT** mentioning any rate or amount. Bids with mention of prices in the Technical Bid shall be rejected.

7.2 Part-II: Financial Bid (Cover-2)

- The Financial Bid shall be submitted strictly in the prescribed BoQ/Financial Bid format (Section 20), with rates filled in the designated cells only.
- Rates shall be quoted item-wise, both in figures and words, inclusive of all costs except GST, which shall be shown separately.
- The Financial Bid shall be submitted in the format provided; any tampering with the format shall render the bid liable to rejection.

Section 8 – Bid Evaluation Methodology

8.1 Preliminary Examination

RPRC shall examine bids to determine whether they are complete, whether the required EMD/exemption has been furnished, whether documents are properly signed, and whether the bids are generally in order. Bids not substantially responsive shall be rejected.

8.2 Technical Evaluation

The Technical Bids shall be opened first. Each bid shall be evaluated Technically against the eligibility criteria in Section 4 and the documentary requirements in Section 7.1. Bidders meeting all essential conditions shall be declared 'technically qualified'. RPRC may seek clarification or additional documents from any bidder, provided this does not alter the substance or price of the bid.

8.3 Opening of Financial Bids

Financial Bids of only the technically qualified bidders shall be opened, on a date intimated by RPRC. Technically qualified bidders (or their authorized representatives) may witness the Financial Bid opening, in person

8.4 Evaluation of Financial Bids – L1 Determination

- Evaluation shall be on the basis of the Lowest Evaluated Responsive Bid (L1) determined on the GRAND TOTAL of the Financial Bid (sum of [Quantity × Unit Rate] for all items), exclusive of GST, GST being statutory and reimbursable as per actuals.
- Arithmetical errors shall be corrected on the following basis: if there is a discrepancy between the unit rate and the total amount, the unit rate shall prevail; if there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail. The corrected total shall be binding on the bidder.
- The responsive bidder with the lowest evaluated total price shall be treated as L1 and recommended for award.
- In the event of a tie (two or more bidders quoting the same lowest total), preference shall be given as per applicable Government policy (e.g., MSE/local supplier preference); failing which, the matter shall be decided by drawl of lots in the presence of the tied bidders.

8.5 Reasonableness of Rates

The L1 rates shall be examined for reasonableness with reference to the estimated rates / prevailing market rates. If the L1 rate is considered unreasonably high, RPRC may negotiate with the L1 bidder only, or re-tender, as per OGFR provisions. Abnormally low rates may be examined and, if necessary, suitable safeguards (e.g., additional performance security) obtained.

Section 9 – Award of Contract

- The contract shall be awarded to the technically qualified bidder whose bid is determined to be the Lowest Evaluated Responsive Bid (L1), subject to the bidder being found capable of satisfactorily performing the contract.
- RPRC will issue a Letter of Acceptance (LoA) / Supply Order to the successful bidder. The successful bidder shall convey acceptance and furnish the Security Deposit/Performance Security within the time stipulated.
- The successful bidder shall execute a formal agreement (Section 21) on non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value (at the bidder's cost) within [07] days of issue of the LoA.
- Failure to accept the LoA, furnish Security Deposit, or execute the agreement within the stipulated time shall entail forfeiture of EMD and may lead to action including award to the next responsive bidder (L2) and/or blacklisting.

Section 10 – Delivery Schedule

- The successful bidder shall commence supply immediately on receipt of the Supply Order and complete the supply within 10 days, or as per the phased delivery schedule communicated by RPRC, Bhubaneswar
- Delivery shall be made at the designated site(s) — Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar, Khurda, Odisha — during office hours on working days, after prior intimation to the designated officer.
- Time shall be the essence of the contract. The supplier shall plan transportation so that plants reach the site in fresh and healthy condition of the plants, saplings etc.
- Seasonal flowering plants shall be supplied at the appropriate planting season as directed by RPRC.

10.1 Liquidated Damages for Delay

If the supplier fails to deliver within the stipulated period, RPRC may, without prejudice to other remedies, levy liquidated damages at 0.5% of the value of the delayed supply per week of delay, subject to a maximum of 10% of the value of the delayed supply. Delay attributable to Force Majeure (Section 17) shall be excluded. If delay exceeds the maximum, RPRC may cancel the order for the undelivered portion, forfeit Security Deposit, and procure from elsewhere at the supplier's risk and cost.

Section 11 – Inspection and Acceptance

- All plants shall be inspected at the time of delivery by the designated officer / inspection committee of RPRC with reference to species, size, health and the technical specifications (Section 6).
- Plants found damaged, diseased, wilted, broken, dead, under-sized, or not conforming to specifications shall be rejected at the time of delivery.
- The supplier shall replace all rejected/dead/damaged plants free of cost within [3–7] days of intimation, failing which may procure equivalent plants from elsewhere at the supplier's risk and cost, recovering the difference from the supplier's dues / Security Deposit.
- Acceptance shall be recorded only in respect of plants found conforming and in good condition. Payment shall be made only for accepted quantities.
- The decision of RPRC/ inspection committee regarding quality, health and conformity of plants shall be final and binding.

Section 12 – Payment Terms

- Payment shall be made for the actual quantity of plants delivered, inspected and accepted, at the accepted unit rates, plus applicable GST.
- No advance payment shall be made.
- The supplier shall submit a proper GST-compliant tax invoice along with delivery challan and the inspection/acceptance report.
- Payment shall ordinarily be released within 30 days of submission of a complete and correct bill duly certified by the designated officer, through electronic mode (NEFT/RTGS) to the supplier's bank account.
- Statutory deductions (income tax / TDS, GST-TDS where applicable, and any other levy) shall be made at source as per law.
- Payment shall be subject to RPRC being satisfied that the supply has been completed and accepted, and after adjustment of liquidated damages / recoveries, if any.

Section 13 – GST and Tax Provisions

- Quoted rates shall be Inclusive of GST. GST AS APPLICABLE shall be shown separately in the Financial Bid and the invoice, and shall be paid/reimbursed at the actual applicable rate against a valid tax invoice.
- The supplier shall be solely responsible for correct classification (HSN), charging and depositing of GST and for filing of returns. RPRC shall not be liable for any error, default or penalty on the part of the supplier.
- Live plants and certain horticultural produce may attract NIL or concessional GST. The applicable rate as per the GST law in force on the date of supply shall apply; the supplier shall charge only the legally applicable rate.
- Any change in GST rates by statute after the last date of bid submission and during the currency of the contract shall be to the account of RPRC subject to submission of documentary proof by the Bidder.
- TDS under the Income Tax Act and GST-TDS under as applicable shall be deducted at source.

Section 14 – Performance Obligations & Security Deposit

14.1 Security Deposit / Performance Security

- The successful bidder shall furnish a Security Deposit / Performance Security equal to 3% of the total value of the Supply Order, immediately of issue of the LoA, by way of Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque/ EFT in favour of [Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar].
- Eligible MSEs/SHGs/FPOs shall be allowed security as provided under applicable under Government policy.
- The Security Deposit shall be returned within 30 days after satisfactory completion of the entire supply and replacement obligations (if any), without interest.
- The Security Deposit shall be liable to forfeiture, in whole or in part, in the event of breach of any term of the contract, non-supply, supply of sub-standard plants, or failure to replace rejected plants.

14.2 General Performance Obligations

- The supplier shall supply plants strictly conforming to the agreed specifications, in the required quantities and within the delivery schedule.
- The supplier shall be responsible for safe transportation and delivery of plants in healthy condition at the designated site.
- The supplier shall promptly replace, free of cost, any plant found dead/damaged/diseased at the time of delivery/inspection.
- The supplier shall comply with all applicable laws, including labour laws, environmental norms and quarantine/phytosanitary requirements, if any.

Section 15 – General Terms and Conditions

- **Subletting / Assignment:** The supplier shall not sublet, assign or transfer the contract or any part thereof without the prior written consent of the Procuring Entity.
- **Conditional Bids:** Conditional bids, or bids with deviations from essential conditions, are liable to rejection.
- **Variation in Quantity:** RPRC may vary item quantities by up to $\pm 25\%$ at the accepted rates (see Section 5).
- **Risk Purchase:** On default of the supplier, RPRC may procure from alternative sources at the supplier's risk and cost, recovering any excess expenditure from the supplier.
- **Termination:** RPRC may terminate the contract for default, by written notice, in the event of breach, persistent sub-standard supply, or failure to perform; and for convenience, with reasonable notice, paying for accepted supplies up to the date of termination.
- **No Waiver:** Failure of RPRC to enforce any right shall not constitute a waiver thereof.
- **Notices:** All notices shall be in writing and delivered to the addresses specified in the contract / by e-mail, and shall be deemed effective on receipt.
- **Compliance with Rules:** The contract shall be governed by OGFR, GFR (to the extent applicable), the Indian Contract Act, 1872, and all applicable Central and State laws.
- **Entire Agreement:** This tender document, the LoA / Supply Order, and the executed agreement shall together constitute the entire contract between the parties.

Section 16 – Dispute Resolution and Jurisdiction

- **Amicable Settlement:** The parties shall first endeavour to settle any dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with the contract amicably through mutual discussion.
- **Reference to Authority:** Failing amicable settlement, the dispute shall be referred to the [**Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar**] of the Procuring Entity, whose decision shall be sought before any further proceedings.
- **Arbitration:** Disputes not resolved as above shall be referred to arbitration by a sole arbitrator to be appointed in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended). The seat and venue of arbitration shall be Bhubaneswar, Odisha, and the proceedings shall be conducted in English/Odia.
- **Governing Law & Jurisdiction:** The contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Subject to the arbitration clause, the Courts at [Bhubaneswar / District Headquarters], Odisha, shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
- **Continuance of Work:** Notwithstanding any dispute, the supplier shall, unless otherwise directed, continue to perform its obligations under the contract.

Section 17 – Force Majeure

- Neither party shall be liable for failure or delay in performance of its obligations if such failure or delay is caused by events beyond its reasonable control, including acts of God, floods, cyclones, earthquakes, fire, epidemic/pandemic, war, riots, strikes, or restrictions imposed by Government (“Force Majeure”).
- The affected party shall notify the other party in writing within 7 days of the occurrence of the Force Majeure event, with particulars, and shall use reasonable efforts to mitigate its effect.
- If the Force Majeure event continues beyond [30] days, either party may terminate the contract by written notice, without liability, save for payment for supplies already accepted.
- No liquidated damages shall be levied for delay solely and directly attributable to a duly notified Force Majeure event.
